HYMN STORY

When I Survey the Wondrous Cross

“When I Survey the Wondrous Cross” is often considered the greatest hymn by Isaac Watts. It was written for a communion service in 1707. Originally the title was “Crucifixion to the World by the Cross of Christ.” That sentiment can be seen in lines such as, “All the vain things that charm me most, I sacrifice them to His blood,” and “Love so amazing so divine demands my soul, my life, my all.”

Watts was born in Southampton, England in 1674. As a young child he loved books and learned how to read at an early age. He had a propensity for rhyming, even in normal conversations.

Watts was an accomplished theologian and logician, but is best known for the hymns he wrote. He is credited with over 650 hymns, and is known as the “Father of English Hymnody.” Before Watts, the normal practice in public worship was to sing metrical versions of the Psalms. However, Watts started to change that by writing paraphrases of the Psalms, which are still some of the most popular hymns in the Christian church. Some examples are “Jesus Shall Reign” (from Psalm 72), “O God, Our Help in Ages Past” (Psalm 90), and “Joy to the World” (Psalm 98).
